

# Edinboro Youth Camps

## *Job Description*

### Worker

#### **Objectives:**

- To glorify the Lord Jesus Christ
- To impact lives for the Kingdom
- To set aside selfish interests for the best interest of the camp

#### **Supervision:**

- See Chain of Command (*Posted at Camp*)

#### **Qualifications:**

- Have received Jesus Christ as Savior
- Have a desire to grow spiritually and to see others grow in their relationship with Jesus Christ
- Have a servant's heart
- Must be at least 14 years old and willing to secure working papers from your school district
- Must be in agreement with the worker's job description and be willing to abide by the rules of the camp
- Must be able to perform physical labor
- Must be able to accept authority and work for other people
- Must be able to accept fellow workers and to work well with other people

#### **General Responsibilities:**

- Shall be responsible for the safety of others as well as yourself at camp
- Shall take all problems to the *Assistant Director* or to those to whom he or she may delegate responsibility (except for issues that fall under Matthew 18:15,16)
- Shall endeavor to constantly maintain a positive Christ-like attitude and, under all circumstances, be supportive of the leaders of the camp

#### **Specific Responsibilities:**

##### A. *Pre-camp*

- Attend orientation and training session

##### B. *In-camp*

- To serve all meals and snacks in the cafeteria
- To clean up after each meal according to the assignments
- To daily, or as asked, clean the restroom facilities
- To assist in trash and garbage removal from the grounds as requested
- To stock, operate and clean up the camp store during its open hours
- To help with any ground maintenance, i.e. scraping and painting buildings, gardening, etc.
- To attend all services unless work is to be done
- To keep their own quarters neat and clean at all times
- To attend daily devotions as a group and maintain personal habits of Bible reading and prayer
- To give assistance to the Program Director, Assistant Director, Athletic Director, Counselor and campers as needed

##### A. *Post-camp*

- Complete cleaning of camp as directed by the Assistant Director
- Clean and close your cabin, this includes doors and windows
- Set up registration area for the next camp
- Seek approval for dismissal from Program Director before leaving
